[Translator's notes: the question marks after the grooms' names indicate a profession that I can't translate. It is not clear what some of these are. Pastor Kühne sometimes wrote very small, making it difficult to make out the letters. In some cases, he uses the German word for a profession (i.e., *Kaufmann* for merchant); in other cases, he uses what appears to be a German transliteration of an English word (i.e., *Blachschmied* for blacksmith). And he is not consistent, i.e., using *Schlachter*, *Fleischer* and *Bütscher* for "butcher."

The formula used for the bride's name is "Louise Beinert *in* Stapleton, Anna Menger *in* Tompkinsville," etc. However, I believe the "in" should be translated "of"; so they would read "Louise Beinert *of* Stapleton, etc." Sometimes, though, he uses *aus*; therefore, I have just translated what is written.]
